This included a great draw against Prince George's school team which was billed as Roundheads v Cavaliers. They were winners of a Bronze award.

The U9s also were in terrific form coming 13th out of 23. They also won one, drew two and lost three. All but one game being extremely close. This gave them the Silver award.

These great results meant both teams were the top performing Wirral teams.
