School Money

A reminder of your log in information for school dinners has been sent out. Dinners can only be paid via this on-line system.

Any amount can be paid at any time but for your information the amount of dinner



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money due for the half term to October is £74.80 or if you wish to pay up until the Christmas break £160.60. Otherwise £11 per week should be paid prior to each Monday (£2.20 a day).

If you child is not on school dinners but would like to take a meal on a Friday please ensure your £2.20 for that meal is paid in advance.



Pupils should be provided with a healthy snack for morning break which is either fresh fruit or vegetables or dried fruit. Alternatively, pupils can pay for a slice of toast. Pupils should not consume crisps or sugary snacks during morning break. Pupils will be reminded regularly of this instruction.

Building Work

During holiday, the summer commenced extensive building an project to replace the KS1 toilet facilities. Before the new facilities could be fitted, it was necessary to excavate the entire area to its foundations and replace and reroute the existing drains. Due to the extent of the work required, the project is running behind schedule and will be finished in the next few weeks. To



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ensure the safety of everybody in school, the area is currently cordoned off. We wish to assure you that the children have full access to toilet facilities and the safety of everybody in school is not compromised.

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Behaviour Policy

As explained in a letter to parents at the end of term, one of our school improvement priorities for this year is to improve, where necessary, the expectations of pupils' behaviour at all times of the school day. We have emailed you a copy of the school's revised behaviour policy which can also be downloaded from the website. We ask you to read the policy carefully.

We believe that there is a strong link between good behaviour and high standards of uniform and presentation. We will be encouraging all pupils to take pride in their appearance and we ask that pupils wear the correct school uniform at all times. School shoes should be worn (not trainers). Hair accessories

for girls should be discrete and match the uniform. Boys should not have designs shaved into their hair or dyed unnatural colours. I am sure you will appreciate the importance of emphasising these requirements. Thank you for helping us to enforce the high expectations we expect.

Arrivals and Departures



The opening times for arriving in the school are 8.45am – 8.55am each day. The doors on the main playground will close at 8:55am. On arrival at the classroom, a member of staff will record your child's attendance in the daily register which closes at 9.00am. Children arriving after 8.55am must come into school via the front reception door and register with staff at the school office. Please note that pupils arriving in the classroom after 9:00am will receive a late mark.



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Departures ->

Our school policy is that no pupil in Foundation Stage, Years 1, 2, 3 and 4 should walk to or from school on their own or be left on their own on the school premises either before or after school. Pupils in these year groups must be collected at the end of the school day.

Parents of pupils in Years 5 and 6 may decide that their child can walk home alone. Your child will be prevented from walking home unless this permission has been given in writing. A separate letter has been sent home to Year 5 and 6 parents with further information.




