



We will be placing a uniform order at the end of next week so if you require any items of uniform in time for the Summer term please put your request in early next week.


As from **Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> April**, the children are welcome to start wearing the summer alternatives to the school uniform:

You will have noticed that 'No Parking' traffic cones have been installed on School Lane to alert everyone to this instruction. Thank you for your help.


