


Letters went home last week about our Film Night on Thursday 16th March. If your child wishes to attend, any last minute permission slips and payment must be handed in on Monday 13th March.

Parents' evenings will take place on **Tuesday 21st March** and **Wednesday 22nd March**.



St Chad's Golden Jubilee




Thank you to all who took part in and attended the celebratory service at St Chad's last Sunday. It was a very special occasion and lovely to see so many of our families there.

Entrance to the School building


