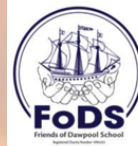

Families of the pupils receiving music tuition in school are invited to attend the concert; including Year 4 parents whose children will be singing.

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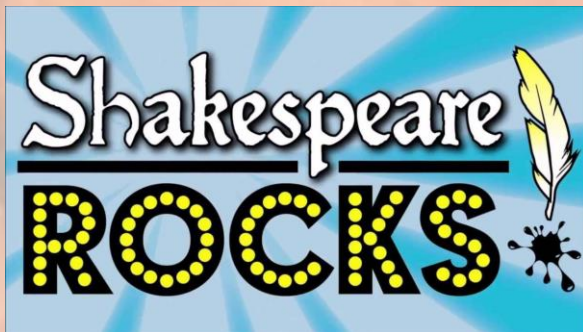
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Shakespeare Rocks!

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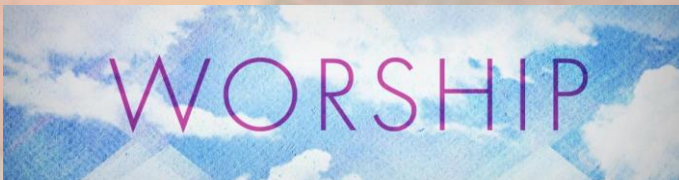
