





Evenings. These will take place on Tuesday 21st March & Wednesday 22nd March. We will be writing to you after the half term holiday with further information.



We are ambitious for realising our vision of being 'the very best Church School' and your views will ensure that we prioritise the things that are important to you and your child.





On <u>Sunday 5th March</u>, St Chad's Church will celebrate its 50th Anniversary. We are delighted to be working with Irby Primary School in






