Please note that the registration window closes on <u>31st May.</u> If parents are unable to register online, they can obtain paper forms by calling the Call Centre on 0151 666 4600.

Parents who do not wish their child to sit the 11+ examination do not need to register.

Behaviour Policy 2023-24

Dawpool is currently introducing a new behaviour policy which has been carefully developed over several months. Teachers have collaborated to discuss the changes and have received up-to-date training on positive behaviour management during the INSET day earlier this month.

The most significant alteration in the behaviour policy is the elimination of the coloured zones for behaviour. Instead, the approach focuses on the principle of "praise in public and remind in private," and is more closely aligned with Dawpool's Christian vision and values.

The new policy aligns with six recommendations that have been outlined in the Education Endowment Foundation (EEF) guidance on Improving Behaviour in Schools (2021).
