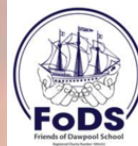

This week marks exactly two years since the first national lockdown and COVID infections are still very prevalent in our school community. The imperative

remains to reduce any disruption to the children's education.

We currently have some members of staff absent from school with COVID-19 and we are having to deploy staff flexibly across the school to cover absence. We appreciate your understanding with this and hope that the situation will improve as we move into the summer term.

A few points to note:

- If you have any of the main symptoms of COVID-19 or a positive test result, the public health advice is to **stay at home, and avoid contact with other people.**
- Children with COVID-19 **should not** attend school while they are infectious. They should take an LFD test from 5 days after their symptoms started (or the day their test was taken if they did not have symptoms) followed by another one the next day. If both these test results are negative, they can return to school, as long as they feel

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well enough to do so and do not have a temperature.
