COVID-19 Update

Thank you for all that you are doing to keep our school community safe at this time. Schools are experiencing increasing numbers of COVID cases and many schools have had to close classes.

We want to ensure that all classes can remain open until the end of term. We therefore want to provide a few reminders:

If your child develops symptoms of COVID, a **cough and/or high temperature**, (even if you think it isn't COVID), they should have a **PCR test** and stay at home. Any siblings should also stay at home (even if no symptoms) until the result is received which is usually within 24 hours. If the PCR test is negative, your child can return to school and all close contacts can stop isolating. If the PCR is positive, your child must self-isolate for 10 days along with anyone else in the household and you must inform the school immediately.

Lateral flow testing at home is not recommended for primary aged children.

We really do understand the inconvenience of awaiting test results, particularly when pupils are at home and parents need to work. Please note that if you are in the position of needing to take time off work to look after a child who is self-

isolating, you may be able to get some financial support. You can find more details and check your eligibility for this payment at www.wirral.gov.uk/covidpayment. The payment scheme is being administered by Wirral Council and any queries can be directed to COVID19foodteam@wirral.gov.uk.
