Arrangements for this year's event are well under way and we have received some information from the Santa comes to Irby Collaborative Group as follows:

Funding for the lights

'Whilst we were delighted to receive a grant from Wirral Borough Council towards the repair of the three animated lights, the year-on-year costs of having the lights installed professionally and taken down again afterwards (usually £1500 per annum) continues to offer a challenge.

We are grateful for donations thus far received from the Shippons Bike Show, the Shippons' cider and sausage festival and last year's Go Fund Me appeal. We are also pleased to hear of other donations due this year from ITPAS, Irby Primary School's Christmas jumper day, The Irby Club, and The Shippons Halloween party. We hope to have another "Go Fund Me" appeal so that

members of the public may donate directly.

Due to the recent change in habit to using card payments, and the Covid risks of cash handling, it is unlikely we will be issuing collecting tins for shop counters this year.
