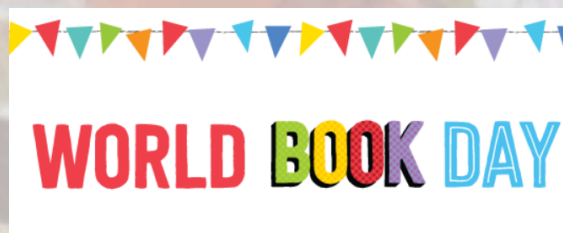


### FoDS News
