Christmas Assemblies 2021

We are looking forward to welcoming you into school over the next two weeks to watch the children's Christmas assemblies.

So that everyone can enjoy a healthy and happy Christmas holiday, we want to do all we can to keep everyone safe when attending school. We therefore ask that all adults attending school to watch the assemblies abide by the following instructions:

1. Please ensure only **1-adult per child** attends each assembly.

So that we can verify that each child has only one audience member, adults will be asked to sign a register on arrival. Please ensure that pre-school aged children do not attend and are looked after by family or friends.

2. Please wear a **face-covering** during the assembly (unless medically exempt).

You will be aware that face coverings are now a legal requirement in some places. Schools are strongly advised to ask staff and visitors to wear masks in communal areas.

Please note that we are unable to film the assemblies, but we will provide the opportunity for adults attending to take photographs to share with family members.

Thank you for your support in ensuring our Christmas assemblies are safe and enjoyable for all concerned.

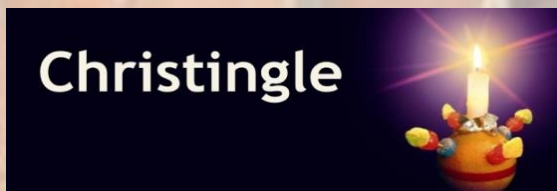
