Dear Parents and Carers,

It may have been a cold and drizzly week but that has not stopped the fun at school. Staff have been spending time at lunchtime enhancing our provision which has resulted in informal drop in clubs including tennis, basketball, lego, computing and drumming. I would like to thank both teachers and teaching assistants for providing these additional opportunities for our children during unstructured times.

I would also like to thank the parents who have expressed an interest in being part of our new Parent Forum. The first meeting will take place on 25th February and we will be joined by our catering manager and foodservice consultant.

It has come to my attention that during drop-off and pick-up times on School Lane, a number of cars are left idling while waiting. As many of our children and families walk along this road every day, this can mean they're passing through exhaust fumes unnecessarily.

We'd really appreciate parents and carers supporting us by switching off engines if you're waiting for a short time. It's a small change that can make a big difference to air quality, children's health, and our environment.

I am really looking forward to next week as it is Mental Health Week. On Monday, Mrs Barrick will be launching the week and introducing the 'Family Challenge', which will be sent home for children to complete with their families. On Tuesday, Koala North West will be using the meeting room to deliver a parent workshop on children's sleep at 9am, alongside class activities focused on creating welcome posters for our school. The MHST Team will also run Friendship and Belonging workshops for Years 3-6. Wednesday includes an MHST parent coffee morning drop-in session at 9am in the hall, with playground activities encouraging children to include others. On Thursday, classes will work together to create a Whole Class Belonging Mosaic. The week concludes on Friday with a non-uniform day to raise money for the Place2Be mental health charity, inviting children to wear something that makes them feel comfortable and included, bring a donation, and take part in inclusive playground games. I think that by the end of the week we will all be ready for half term!
