# Parents' Evening Appointments Online Booking



Appointments can be booked through our school website with the login details which have been previously advised.

Please note that parents' evening appointments are 10-minutes duration. In fairness to everybody, it is important that we keep appointments running to schedule, so please make sure you end your appointment within the allotted time.

If you are booking consecutive appointments for siblings, we suggest you leave a short period between appointments to allow time to move between appointments. Thank you for your support in ensuring our parents' evenings run smoothly.

#### **World Book Day**



We are celebrating World Book Day on Friday 8th March. Pupils are invited to accessorise their uniform or dress up as a book character if they want to on that day. Several activities have been planned for pupils to enjoy.

> Easter Service 2024 Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> March, 2:15pm



Families of children in Years 3-6 are invited to join us for an Easter Service at St Chad's Church on **Wednesday 27**<sup>th</sup> **March at 2:15pm**. Pupils in Y3-6 will leave school after lunch to walk to church. The service is expected to last around 40-minutes and parents have the option of taking their child home after the service. More information will follow shortly.

Pupils in F1, F2, Y1 & Y2 will remain in school to take part in a Holy Week experience which will involve a carousel of activities throughout the school, including arts, crafts, storytelling and singing.

#### **Statutory Assessments 2024**

Whilst all schools are required to deliver a range of statutory assessments each year, Dawpool's priority is to ensure that they are always administered in such a way that the children are happy and at ease. In many cases, the children won't be aware that they are doing a test and will approach them as a part of their usual classroom activities.

The timetable for statutory assessments is as follows:

#### **Year 1 Phonics**

The Year 1 Phonics Check will take place during week commencing 10<sup>th</sup> June 2024. The Check is administered on a 1:1 basis with Mrs Ham, or another member of staff who knows your child well, and the children will be unaware it is a 'test'. The children will see it as part of their normal phonics activities. Phonics scores will be shared with parents at the end of the academic year.

#### Year 2 SATS

Please note that Year 2 SATS ended last year and will not go ahead in 2023-24. As in other year groups, Mrs Young will assess your child's work throughout Year 2 to make a teacher-assessed judgement of your child's attainment. The teacher-assessed judgement is shared with





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parents at the end of the academic year.

#### Year 4 Multiplications Tables Check

The Year 4 Multiplication Tables Check will take place any time between 3<sup>rd</sup> – 14<sup>th</sup> June 2023. The Check is administered on a 1:1 basis with Mrs Broadbent or Mrs Warwood, or another member of staff who knows your child well. More information about the Multiplication Tables Check can be found on the DfE website here. The Multiplication Tables Check scores are shared with parents at the end of the academic year.

#### **Year 6 SATs**

Year 6 SATs will take place on the following dates:

#### Monday 13th May

Spelling, Punctuation & Grammar - Paper 1 Spelling, Punctuation & Grammar - Paper 2

Tuesday 14th May English Reading Paper

Wednesday 15th May

Maths Paper 1 (Arithmetic)
Maths Paper 2 (Reasoning)

Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> May Maths Paper 3 (Reasoning) Whilst the Year 6 SATs are more formal in their delivery, we always make sure they are delivered in the most appropriate way for each individual child to ensure they are happy and at ease during the assessments. The results of the Year 6 SATs are shared with parents at the end of the academic year.
