I am pleased to share that we are further enhancing our extra-curricular offer this term. Following discussions with children and also signing up to the Wirral Primary School Netball Pledge, alongside some familiar favourites, this half term we are introducing a number of clubs including Arts & Crafts, Netball and Drama. These opportunities allow children to develop new skills, build confidence and enjoy learning beyond the classroom, and we are very much looking forward to seeing the children take part. Over the coming terms, more clubs will be offered to different year groups.

I would like to extend a very warm welcome to Mrs Millensted, who is now working with us as a Teaching Assistant in Key Stage 1. Many

children and parents will already know Mrs

Millensted well, as she has supported Dawpool for many years through her work as a midday supervisor and within our wraparound care. We are delighted to have her join the KS1 team, and I know the children are already benefiting from her enthusiasm and caring approach.

This week, I met with RPJ3 Catering to explore ways of continuing to improve our school dinners. As a result of these discussions, menus will now include greater detail about ingredients, highlighting where nutritional value has been added to meals. We will also be working closely with RPJ3 to run sessions within classes, giving children the opportunity to learn about food, as well as to make and taste a range of dishes. This will help to encourage children to try new foods and develop a positive relationship with healthy eating.

In addition, we are planning to invite parents from F1 to Year 2 to a special Valentine's lunch on Thursday 12th February. This will provide a lovely opportunity for parents to enjoy lunch with their child, while also seeing and tasting the food that is offered to the children each day.
