We recognise that the PE days are changing quite regularly but hope you appreciate that this is to tie in with the support we receive from Claremount Sports College and Progressive Sports who are offering many varied PE options to the children.

We are also able to offer lunchtime football for girls in Y3-Y6 on a Tuesday next term and lunchtime football to boys from Y3 & Y4 on a Thursday thanks to this support.

Any girls wishing to join the lunchtime football in years 3, 5 & 6 should bring in a kit to change into on a Tuesday and the same applies to any boys in Year 4 who wish to join the lunchtime football on a Thursday. Separate letters have been sent regarding this.

Additionally, we can offer lunchtime tag rugby to any pupil in Y5 and Y6 on a Wednesday. If your child wishes to take part, they will need to bring in a kit and footwear to change into on a Wednesday next term.

Appointments can be booked through our school website with the login details which have been previously advised.



Measles, Mumps and Rubella (MMR) vaccine

The UK Health Security Agency (UKHSA) has reported an increase in measles across the country and is encouraging people to check that

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they and their children have had two doses of the MMR vaccine. The free MMR vaccine is a safe and effective way of protecting against measles, as well as mumps and rubella.

Measles spreads very easily among those who are unvaccinated, especially in nurseries and schools. It can be a very unpleasant illness and, in some children, it can be serious and lead to hospitalisation and complications such as pneumonia, meningitis, blindness or seizures (fits).

Children aged between 12 months and 11 years old who have not received 2 doses of the measles, mumps, and rubella vaccine (MMR) are being offered vaccination by their GP as Wirral's School Aged Immunisation Service will continue to support any missed vaccinations for children in Year 7 and above. Please check your child's Red Book to see if they have received MMR vaccinations as scheduled or check with your GP surgery if you're unsure.

Most healthy adults will have developed some immunity to measles but can still receive two doses of the vaccine from their GP too.

Measles symptoms to be aware of include:

- high fever
- sore, red, watery eyes
- coughing

- aching and feeling generally unwell
- a blotchy red brown rash, which usually appears after the initial symptoms.

Anyone with symptoms is advised to stay at home and phone their GP or NHS 111 for advice.
