Walk to School Week 17th-21st May

Dawpool is taking part in Walk to School Week next week. The nationwide event is organised by walking charity Living Streets and designed to help pupils experience first-hand the importance of walking to school. Children will be well on their way to reaching their recommended 60 minutes minimum of physical activity per day before even reaching the school gates!
