### Who is it for and how many can take part?

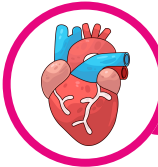

# Here's some of the most popular **O.M.G.**, **Jaw Dropping** activities your child can take part in at the **Future Medics Club!**

Each week your child will be able to complete an awesome workbook so you can see what they have learnt and find out what really got them buzzing.



## Basic Medical Obs

We'll record everything from blood pressure, to oxygen sats to temperature and even record and print their own ECG! (that's the wavy line you see on Holby!)



## Ultrasound Scans

Using our very special ultrasound, we'll be looking for growth plate in their wrist and muscles in the forearm.

They'll also be an opportunity to see their own heart if they want to!



## Respiratory & Lungs

Most children have seen or used a peak flow, but we take it a step further measuring their lung volume with a spirometer! We even record their respiration rate & depth (thats how fast and deep they breath!)



## Keyhole Surgery

Don't panic! They don't try this on each other! Instead they practice on a special training box that surgeons use to hone their surgical skills!



## Strength & Reactions

To be a medic, you have to be fit! So we also have a series of strength tests, including hand grip, pull strength and reactions tests on the Blaze Pods!



## Senses

With a series of weird experiments that explore their senses, this one is guaranteed to make them OMG & LOL! From floating arms, to optical illusions, to discovering if you are super taster... Be prepared to try these at home after the club!



## Blood & Germs

All performed under strict supervision, they can take blood from our training arm, using a real needle. This is the highlight of the club for many pupils!
