Multiplication Tables Check

Year 4 pupils will be taking the statutory multiplication tables check (MTC) for the first time, in June this year. The purpose of the check is to determine whether pupils can fluently recall their times tables up to 12, which is essential for future success in mathematics. The government have published an information leaflet for parents which can be downloaded from the Year 4 class page on the school website.

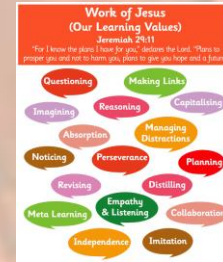

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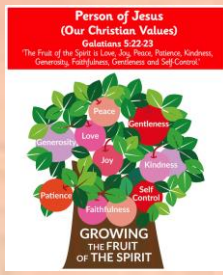
