- 1. A looked after child or a child who was previously looked after.
- 2. Children with special medical or social circumstances affecting the child where these needs can only be met at this school.
- 3. Children with a sibling attending the school at the time of application.
- 4. Children resident in the parish of Thurstaston with Irby and whose parent/s worship in a Christian church.
- 5. Other children resident in the parish of Thurstaston with Irby.
- 6. Other children.

In order to make a change to oversubscription criteria (i.e. how a school assigns places if there are more applicants than places available), a school needs to consult with the wider community for a minimum of 6 weeks between 1 October and 31 January. Dawpool's consultation period begins this week and will end on Monday 31<sup>st</sup> January 2023.
