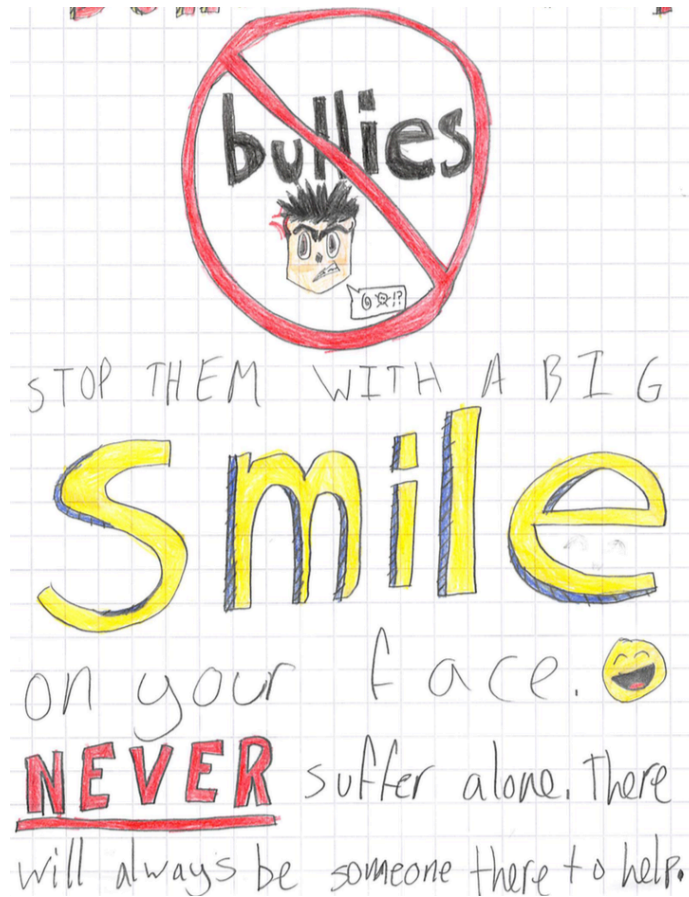

We have agreed that bullying is:

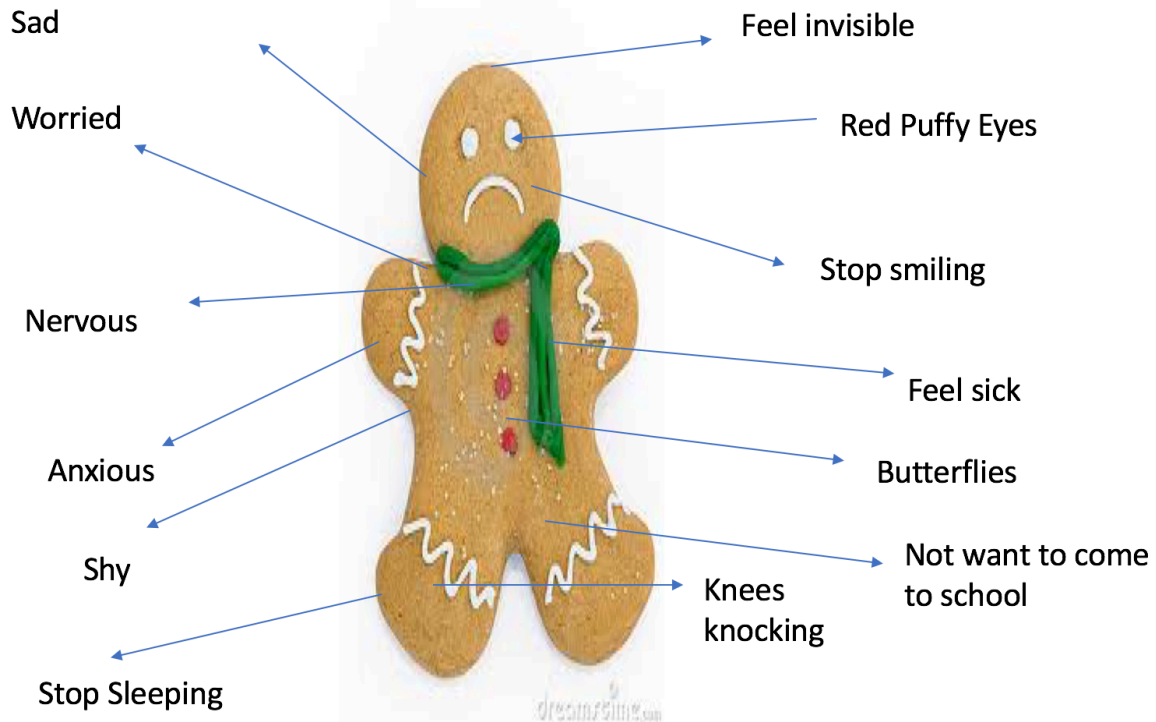
