By the end of this lesson your child should be able to:

Use expanded noun phrases for descriptive specification.

Use expanded noun phrases to add extra writing

Identify nouns and noun phrases.

We recommend the following resources and activities to achieve this objective: Have a balloon and write a noun on it. Blow the balloon up a little and write an adjective to describe the noun. Explain that as the balloon grows we say it expands which is what we are doing to our sentence by adding adjectives to describe our nouns. Keep adding adjectives as you expand the balloon until you have an expanded noun phrase. Look at the attached picture of a Where's Wally scene. Start by saying to your child "Can you find the man?" Then say "oh I'm not being specific enough, Can you find the smiling strong man? Still too hard? Okay can you find the strong, smiling man with a blue hat and an axe?" When they can do this, discuss why it was easier with the last explanation, to find the man. Let them use more adjectives and make an expanded noun phrase. The activity is for your child to come up with their own description for people for you to find. They write down their
