Extreme heat

Predicted Heat Weather Warnings

The Met Office has extended an extreme heat warning for Sunday 17th July, Monday 18th July and Tuesday 19th July, as temperatures will build this weekend and early next week for much of England and Wales. Temperatures could be around 32°C with Monday and Tuesday most likely to see temperatures around this level.

On Monday and Tuesday next week, we will relax our usual school uniform policy and encourage all children to wear their PE kit with safe and sensible footwear (no open toed shoes) and sunhats with wide brims. Sunscreen should be applied before arriving at school, and pupils should bring a water bottle.

We will make sure that the school building is well ventilated, keeping children hydrated, and avoiding vigorous physical activity and prolonged exposure to the sun.



How the Challenge works

- Children sign up through their local library and receive a Gadgeteers collector poster.
- Children set a reading goal and borrow and read library books of their own choice during the summer, collecting special stickers to complete their poster and extra incentives along the way.
- Library staff are on hand to advise and run family-friendly activities.
- All children who take part receive a certificate

- Children who complete the Summer Reading Challenge are presented with a certificate and a medal.


