Confident Parenting in a Digital Age

In this ever-evolving digital age, it can feel overwhelming to keep up with our children's online activities. With technology advancing so rapidly, parents may sometimes feel that their children have more knowledge about the online world than they do.

To support our parents, we have created a new section on our school website called 'Left to Their Own Devices: Confident Parenting in a Digital Age.' This section features 40 minutes of video content, designed to help parents understand the online world that our children inhabit. It addresses common challenges and offers practical tips for parenting in a world of screens.
