After careful consideration of the consultation feedback from stakeholders and after undertaking due diligence, we

are delighted to inform you that the Governing Board have passed a majority resolution in favour of conversion and have made the decision to proceed with submitting an application to convert to academy status and to join CDAT.

The governors have written to all parents this week. A copy of the letter can be found on our website.

As the education sector moves towards a fully trust-led system over the next few years, we are delighted that Dawpool will be moving into a strong and growing academy trust that is rooted in the Church England's Vision for Education, of retaining. protecting further and enhancing our Church of England context. ethos. culture and distinctiveness for generations to come.

As a trust, CDAT has a distinctive ethos that is clearly rooted in Christian values and aims to ensure that all pupils are able to benefit from and enjoy 'life in all its fullness' (John 10:10), a vision which is closely aligned with our own.
