The Remote Learning pages are designed to enable your child to continue learning at home if they are required to self-isolate whilst the rest of their class are in school. In the unfortunate event that a whole year group is required to self-isolate, we will be extending this offer to



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allow interaction, assessment and feedback each day with the class teacher. More information about this will provided when required.
