This week, I have had the pleasure of spending time in Early Years and Key Stage One, both observing and teaching. It has been wonderful to see our new bespoke English curriculum in action. The children have shown real enthusiasm towards the new texts, and it has been a joy to see this reflected in their writing. Books are looking fantastic, with children beginning to engage in positive editing, noticing where they can make corrections and improvements to their work. This is a really important skill, and it is encouraging to see children taking pride and ownership in their learning.

I have also really enjoyed spending time each day this week in F2. They made me feel very welcome during their child-initiated learning, and it has been a pleasure to observe their curiosity, independence and enthusiasm as they explore their learning environment.

I am pleased to share that our extra-curricular offer continues to grow. This week, children in Years 4–6 showed great enthusiasm during a Future Medics assembly, which encouraged them to think about potential future careers within the NHS. Opportunities like these are so valuable in broadening children's horizons and helping them to consider the many pathways open to them.


