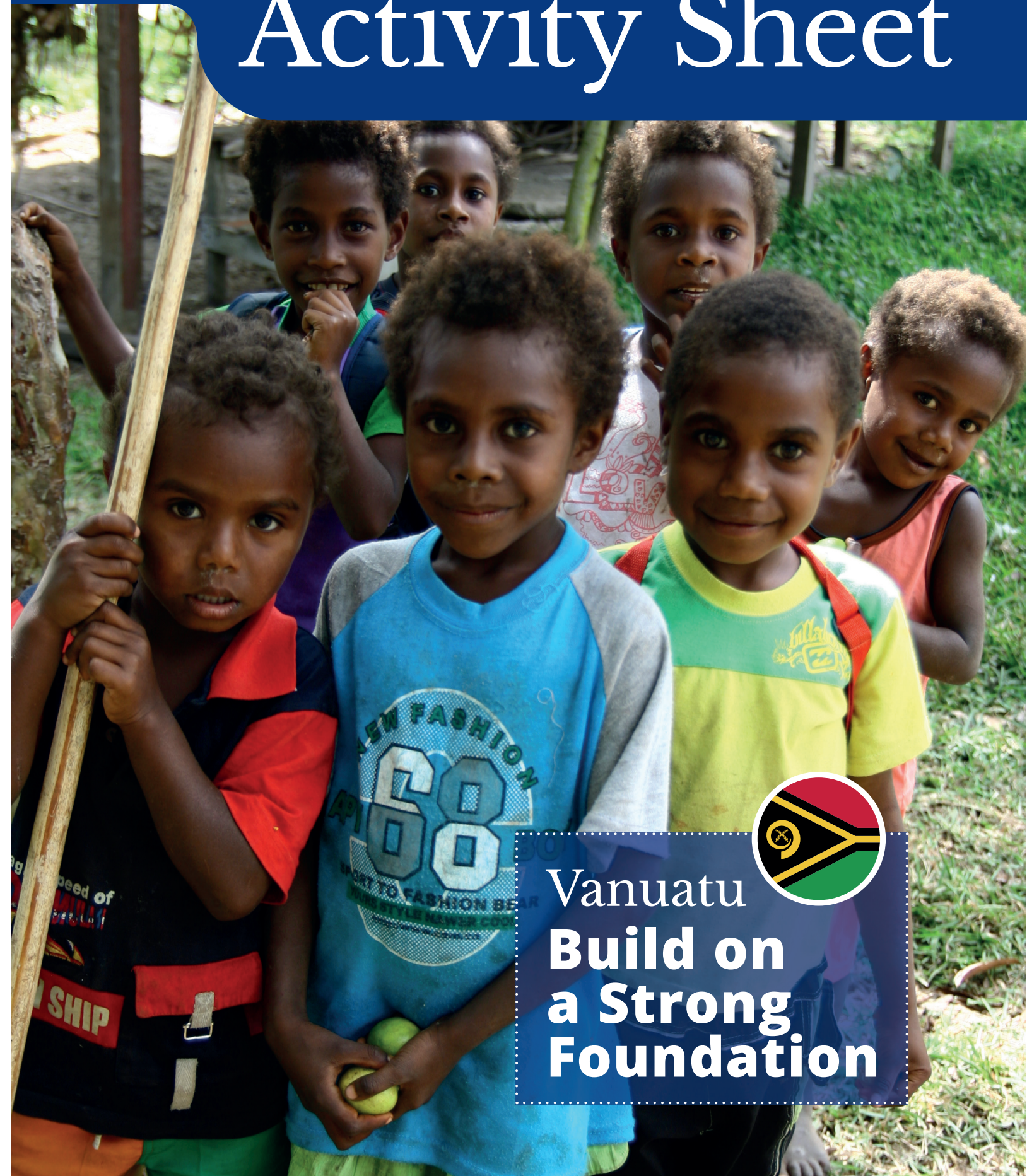
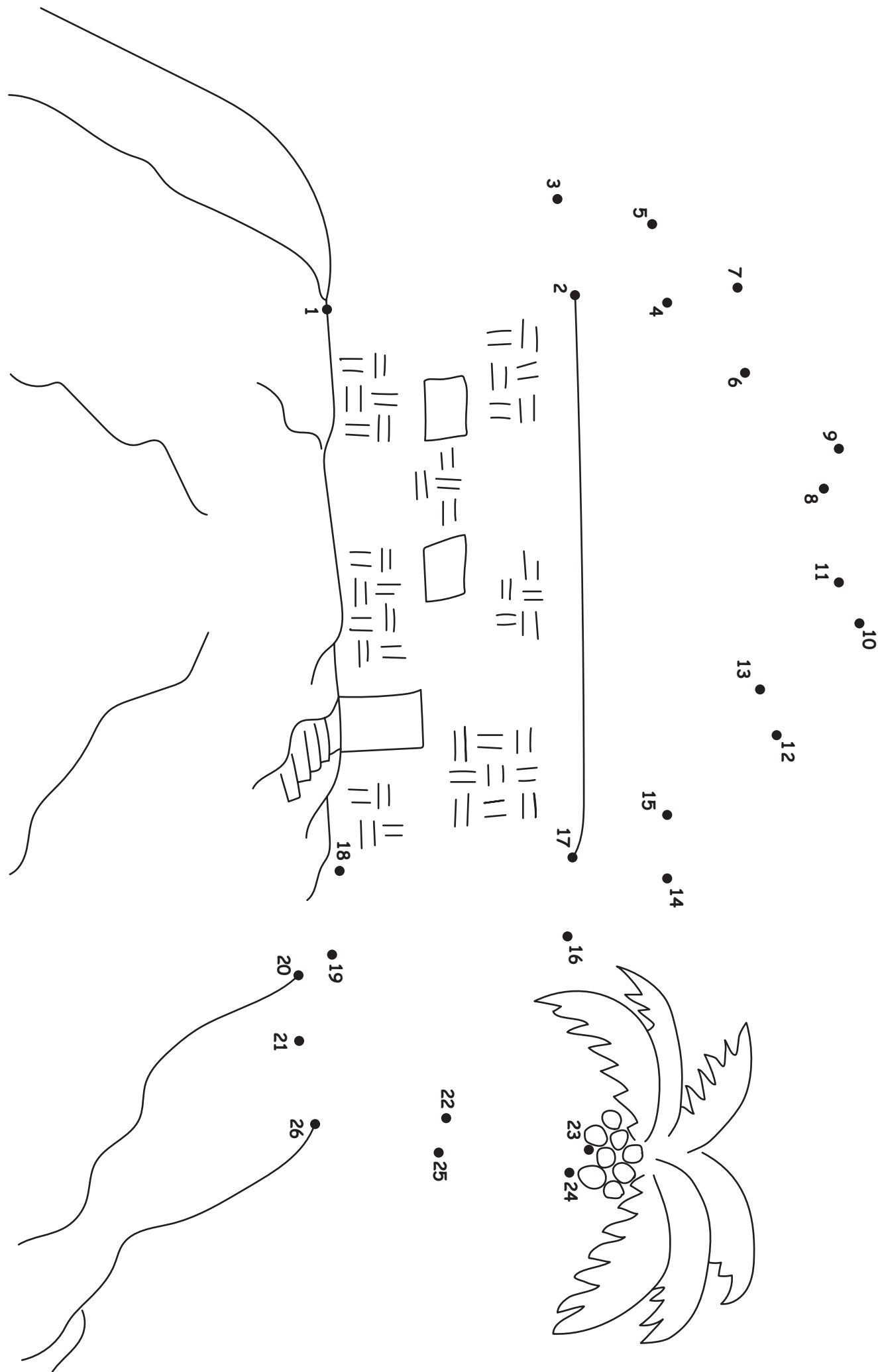

Vanuatu Facts

- The islands of Vanuatu lie in the South Pacific.
- There are several volcanoes and the islands have suffered from floods and cyclones.
- There are two seasons: a hot, humid season from November to March, ending in heavy rains; a cooler dry season from April to October.
- The islands have lush tropical vegetation, with lots of pineapples, bananas, mangoes, sweetcorn, sweet potatoes, yams and taro.
- Farmers keep cows but the most important animal is the wild boar.
- The biggest island is called Santo but the capital, Port Vila is on the island of Efate.
- The people of Vanuatu use coconuts in their cooking and make a stew called lap lap.
- The children of Vanuatu speak the language of their local village. They are taught English, French or Bislama at school.

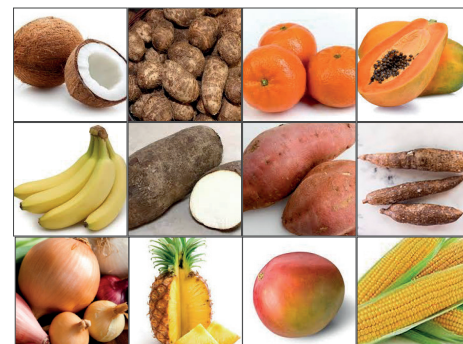
