Cut out the base ten blocks and make a number using the tens and ones. Help your child to say the number. Make more numbers and ask them to say what number it is.

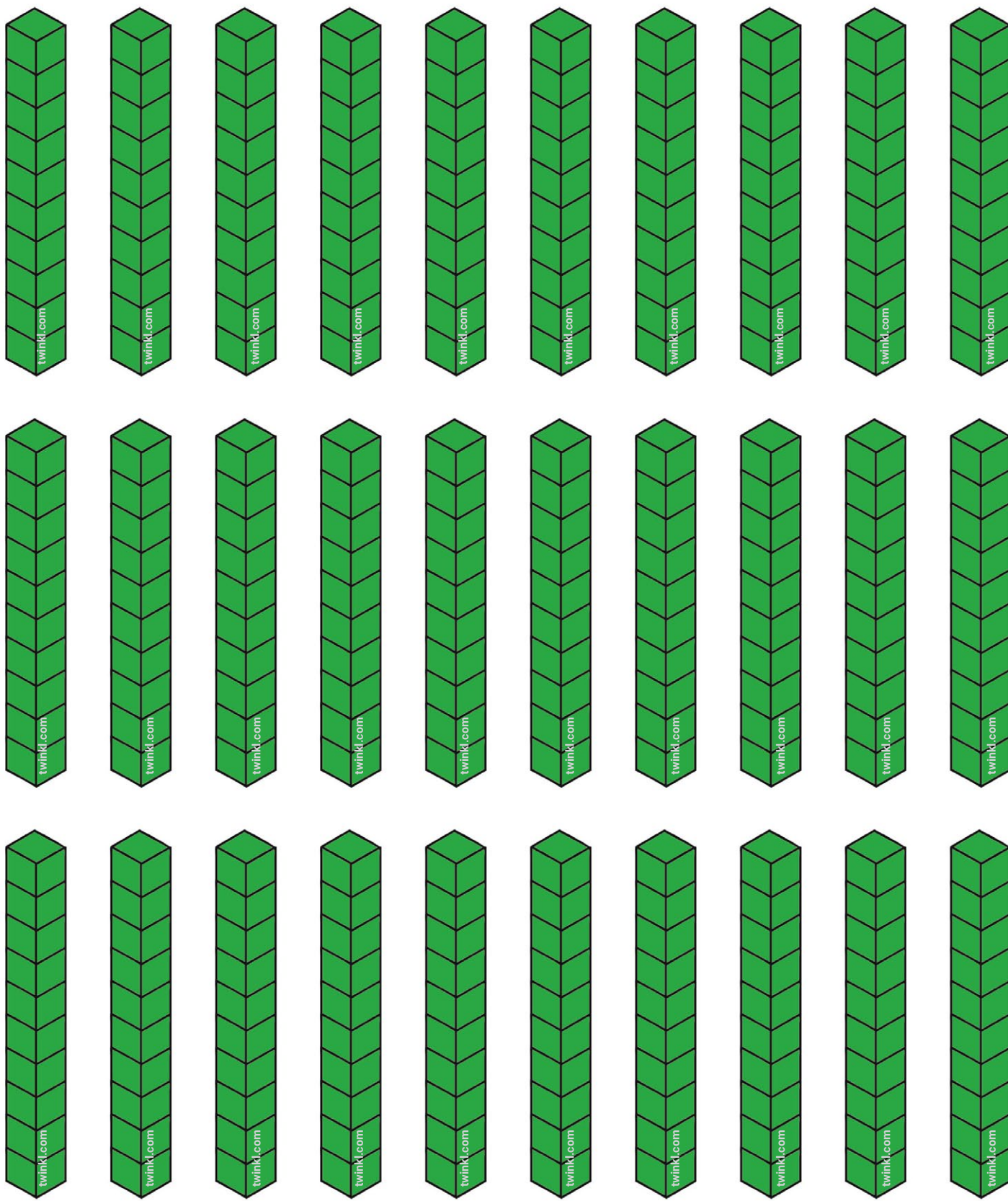
How does this help my children's learning?

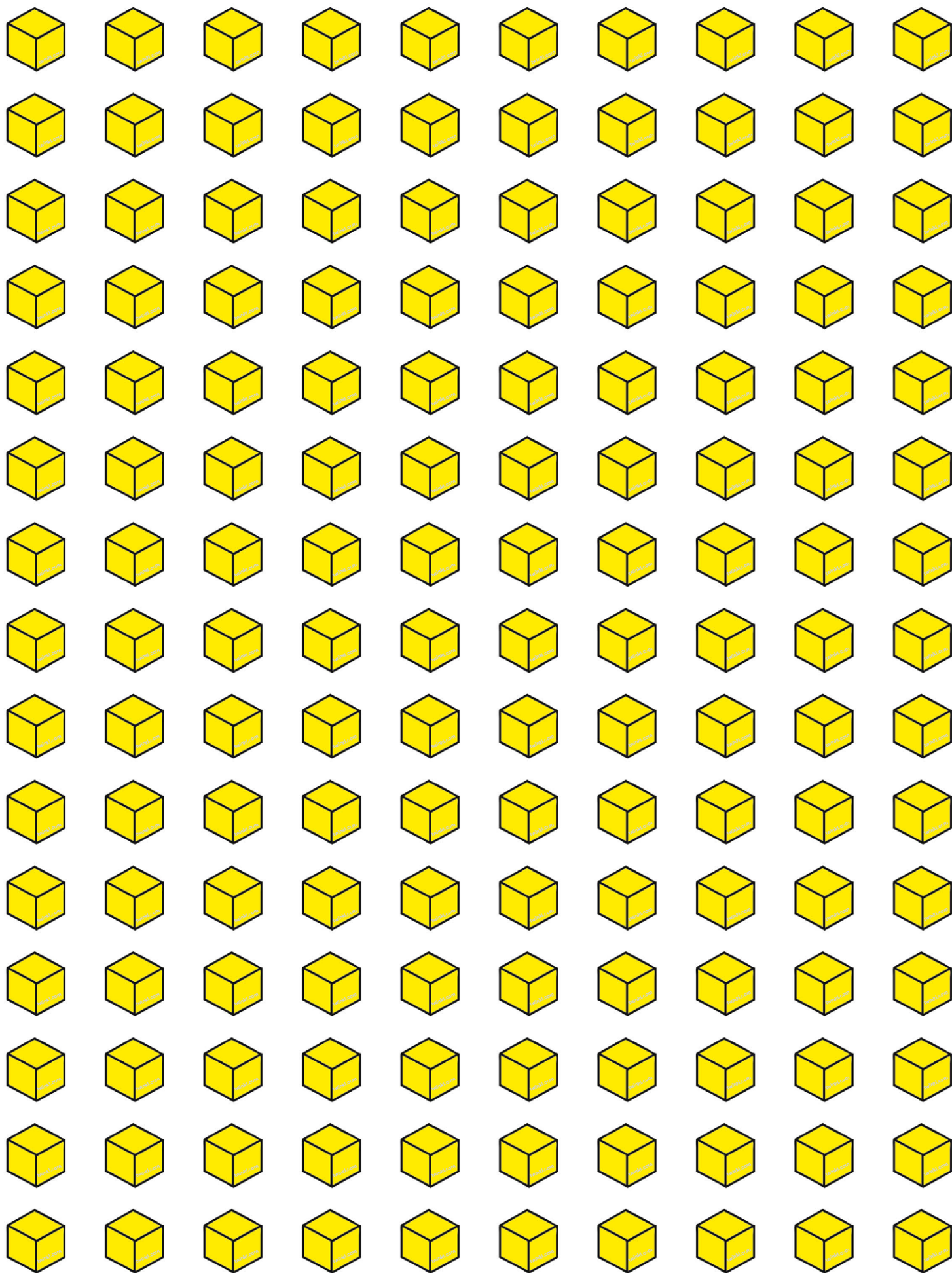
This activity is a practical way to help your child understand what the digits represent in a 2-digit number.

Ask your child to make numbers using the base ten blocks and test you. Say some wrong on purpose to see if they can spot the errors and correct you.

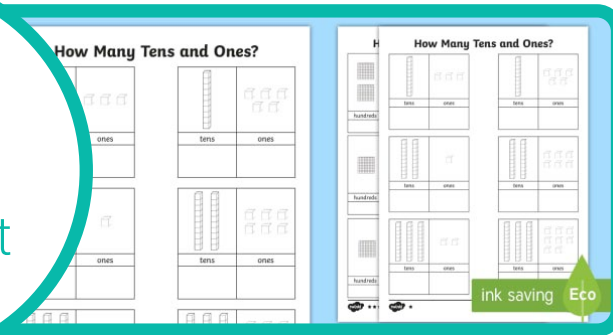




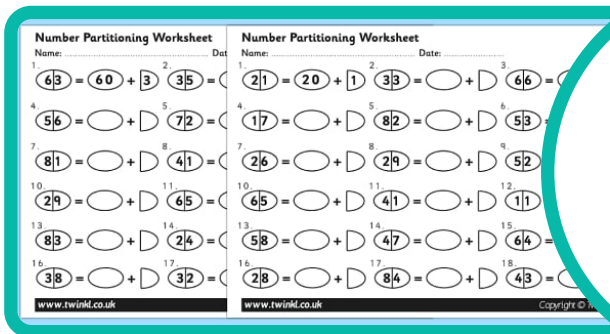

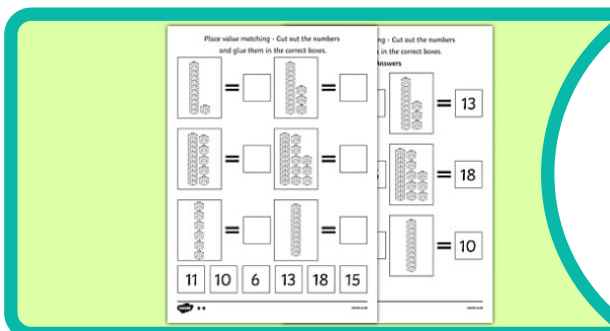
